

# New Mexico JC Wins Indoor Track & Field Championship

New Mexico JC of Hobbs, New Mexico edged Seminole JC of Seminole, Oklahoma, by one point to win the 1979 NJCAA Indoor Track and Field Championship. The meet was held at the University of Missouri, Columbia, Missouri. Santa Fe CC of Gainesville, Florida, finished third with a final total of 71 just one point back of Seminole JC. Another highlight of the meet was the introduction of seven special events for women.
