Johnson County Community College Women Win Second Consecutive Half Marathon Title South Plains College Brings Home First Men's Title

Johnson County Community College continued to dominate the NJCAA Women's Half Marathon Classic, winning the programs third title in four years. South Plains College edged the Johnson County men's team by one point, winning the 2006 title.

Leading Johnson County was freshman **Christa Heideman** and sophomore **Jackie Jamison**, both earning NJCAA All-American honors with top-six finishes. **Heideman** placed fourth overall with a time of 1:27:59 and **Jamison** placed fifth in 1:28:51. Other key efforts were turned in by sophomore **Felicia Fleming** and freshman **Kay Thomason**. **Fleming** placed seventh overall with a time of 1:30:39 and **Thomason** was ninth with a time of 1:32:05.

The South Plains men were led by national champion **John Kosgei** with a time of 1:08.35. Other top performers were **Jay Wilson**, who finished ninth overall with a time of 1:13.25 and **TK Revis**, who finished 13th overall with a time of 1:14.48.
