

# Central Oregon Runner Sets Course Record For Marathon

How fast were the times turned in at the June 4 NJCAA Marathon championships?

Kevin Sweeney, the 1992 men's champion from Lansing (Mich.) Community College, took 31 seconds off his winning time of 2:37:22, but was able to finish no better than seventh.

The best of the six runners who finished ahead of Sweeney was Central Oregon Community College's Mike Dudley, who was clocked in 2:22:15, a course record since the event began in 1987 to be hosted by Oakton Community College in Des Plaines, Ill. The previous mark for Oakton's course at the nearby Forest Preserve District of Cook County

was 2:26:27, turned in by Navajo Community College's Alvin Begay in 1988. Dudley just missed the overall championship record of 2:22:12 set in 1984 by Eric Sruber, of Lansing.

In all, 18 of the 33 finishers in the men's division covered the 26-mile, 285-yard distance in less than three hours.

With three runners in the top eight, South Plains College (Levelland, Texas) won the team competition in the men's division. The only two women's entries in team competition — Colby (Kansas) Community College and Johnson County (Kansas) Community College — tied for first place.

Colby's Leslie Nielsen won the individual women's title in 3:26:24. She earned All-America honors as did runner-up Stacey Hoyt (Lansing) and third-place finisher Chrissy Slavik (Johnson County).

Earning All-America honors in the men's division were the top six finishers: Dudley, Malcolm Campbell (Johnson County), Jackson Makene (South Plains), Jeff Christian (SW Michigan College), Denes Balaz (South Plains) and Brian Chee (SW Indian Polytechnic Institute).
