

HOWARD COUNTY TAKES TRACK TITLE

Howard County Junior College from Big Spring, Texas, runner-up in last year's meet, ran off with the 1967 title in the twenty-eighth running of the NJCAA Track and Field Championships at Garden City, Kansas. The fleet Jayhawks scored 63 points on route to the title, thirteen more than the second place finisher, Mesa Community College from Mesa, Arizona.

Robert Lindsey of Howard County was the meet's high point man with 22½ points. Close behind Lindsey were Jimmy Jasper, also from Howard County, and Bill Aeschlimann of Northeastern (Colorado) with 20½ and 20 points, respectively.

Three new meet records were established and another mark tied as entries from fifty-eight colleges participated. New record holders are Doug Giles, Mesa Community College, Mesa, Arizona, in the 440 yard intermediate hurdles with a time of 54.1; Ed Moreland, Highland Community College, Highland, Kansas, in the javelin with a throw of 230'1"; and Bill Aeschlimann, Northeastern Community College, Sterling, Colorado, in the long jump with a leap of 24'6½". Nevile Myton, also of Mesa Community College, equalled the existing meet mark in the 880 yard run with a time of 1:52.7.
